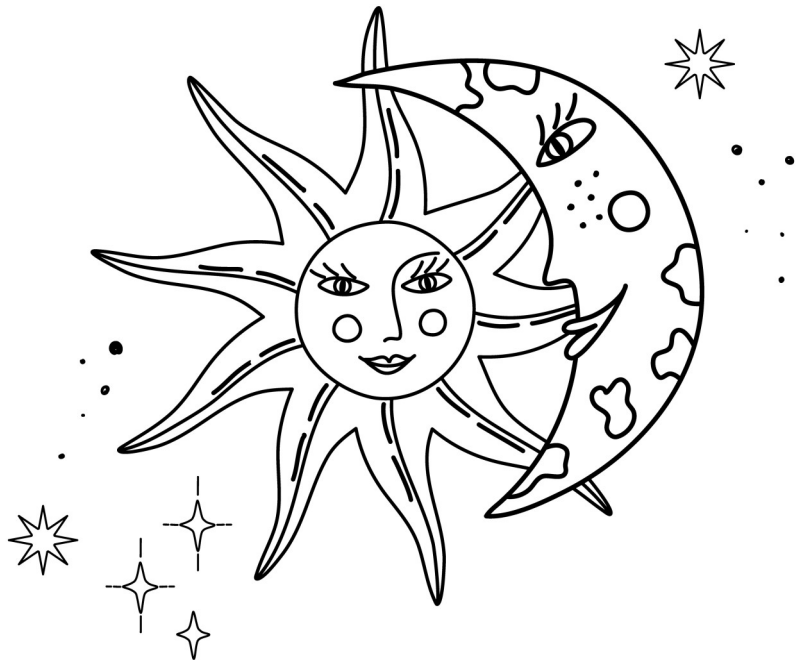
The head of the robot turns left to right...

Monkey sits down in a chair.

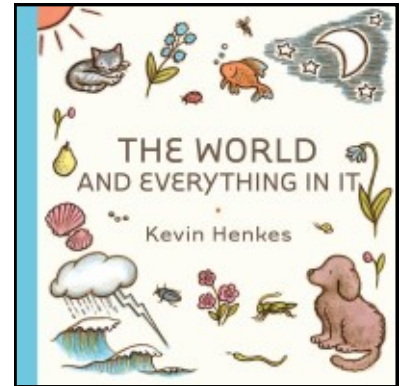
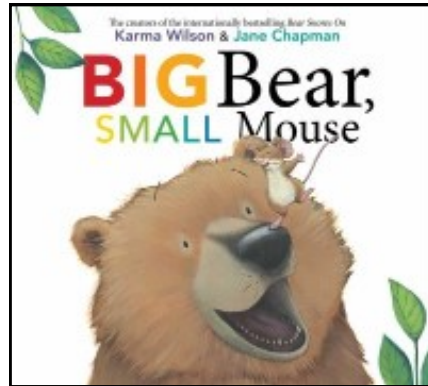
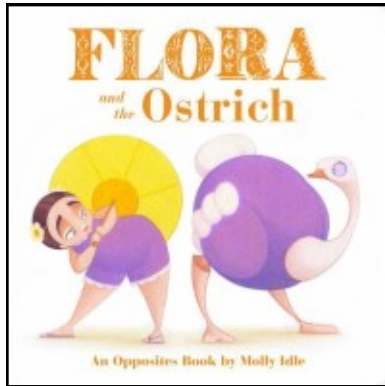
