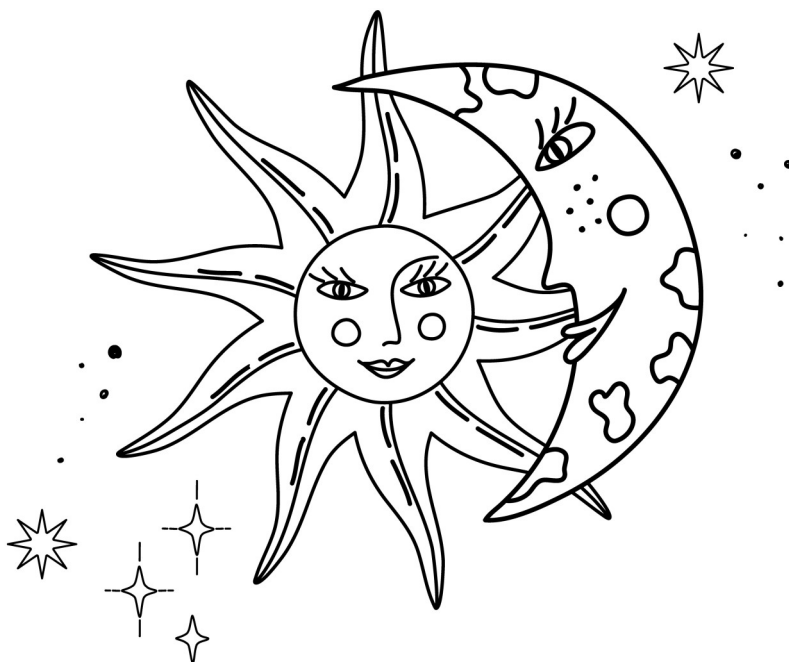
The doors on the bus go open and shut

Five Little Monkeys

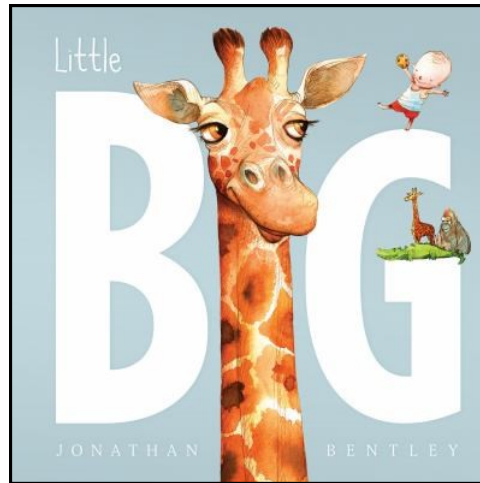
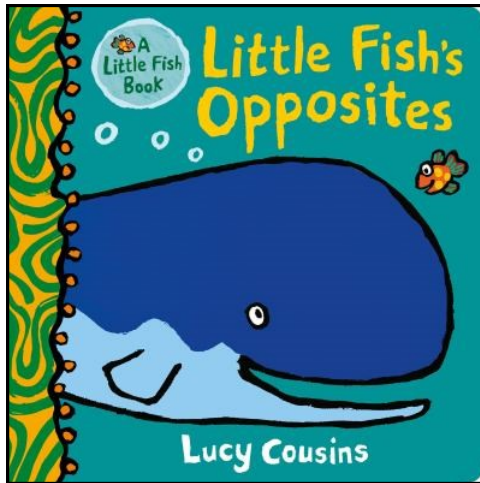
Five little monkeys jumping on the bed

Put those monkeys right to bed



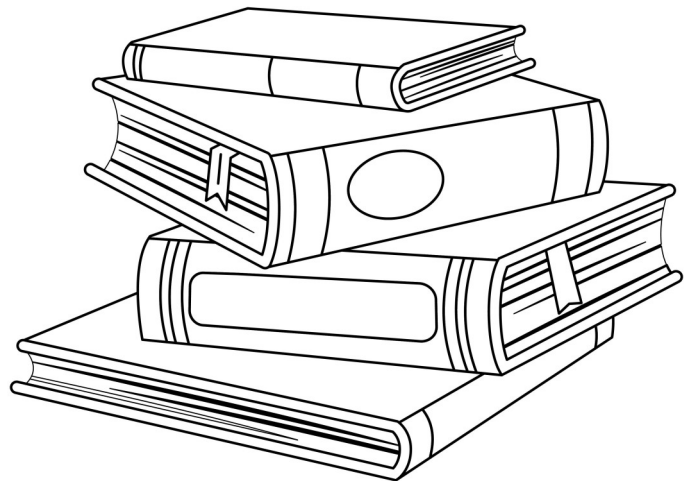

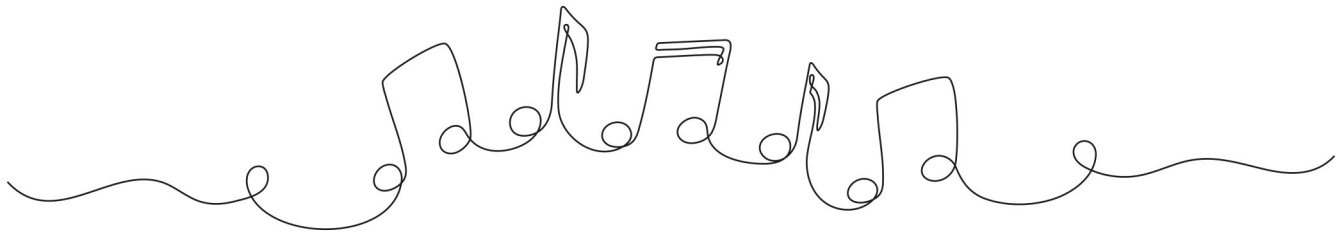
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Every Child Ready to Read Skill
